Circular Economy (MSc)

This program aims at equipping students with tailored, innovative tools to operate into the international context of economic and environmental sustainability.

A multidisciplinary environment leads beyond the Academic framework constructing a new approach to natural resources exploitation and sustainable management of the value from an intersectoral perspective.

The complementarity of lectures, training activities and seminars, and a high-interaction with the non-academic side and stakeholders, constitute the full training course towards advanced skills on the circular economy in a double-transfer of knowledge modality. Necessary to strengthen the future career prospects in a wide area of employment.



Two curricula

Green

focused on industrial production in a circular vision, where each process is characterized by a sustainable approach. Reduction of traditional raw materials, renewable energy, recovery, recycling, the use of natural substances and reuse of waste from other sectors,

Blue

Oriented towards a circular approach to the economy of the sea and maritime affairs in all its forms, tourism, nature, logistics, trade, raw materials and port management

Security and Human Rights (MSc)



- ✓ An educational path in which the traditional dichotomy security vs freedom is revisited in light of three main contemporary challenges: **migration**, **technology** and **sustainability**.
- ✓ Students are provided with the **multidisciplinary competences** they need to disentangle complex phenomena, to work in **strategic fields** (e.g. border security, new technologies, green economy) and to compete for **high-level positions**, both at national level and at European and international level
- ✓ Students can take all courses *online* (at distance) or in presence
- **First year** aimed at providing advanced knowledge on how to balance security and human rights
- **Second year** includes two alternative paths with a higher level of specialization: one on **Security and Human Mobility** and the other on **Security, Technology and Sustainability**

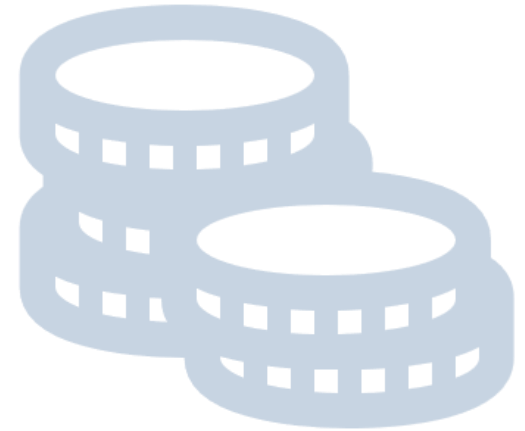

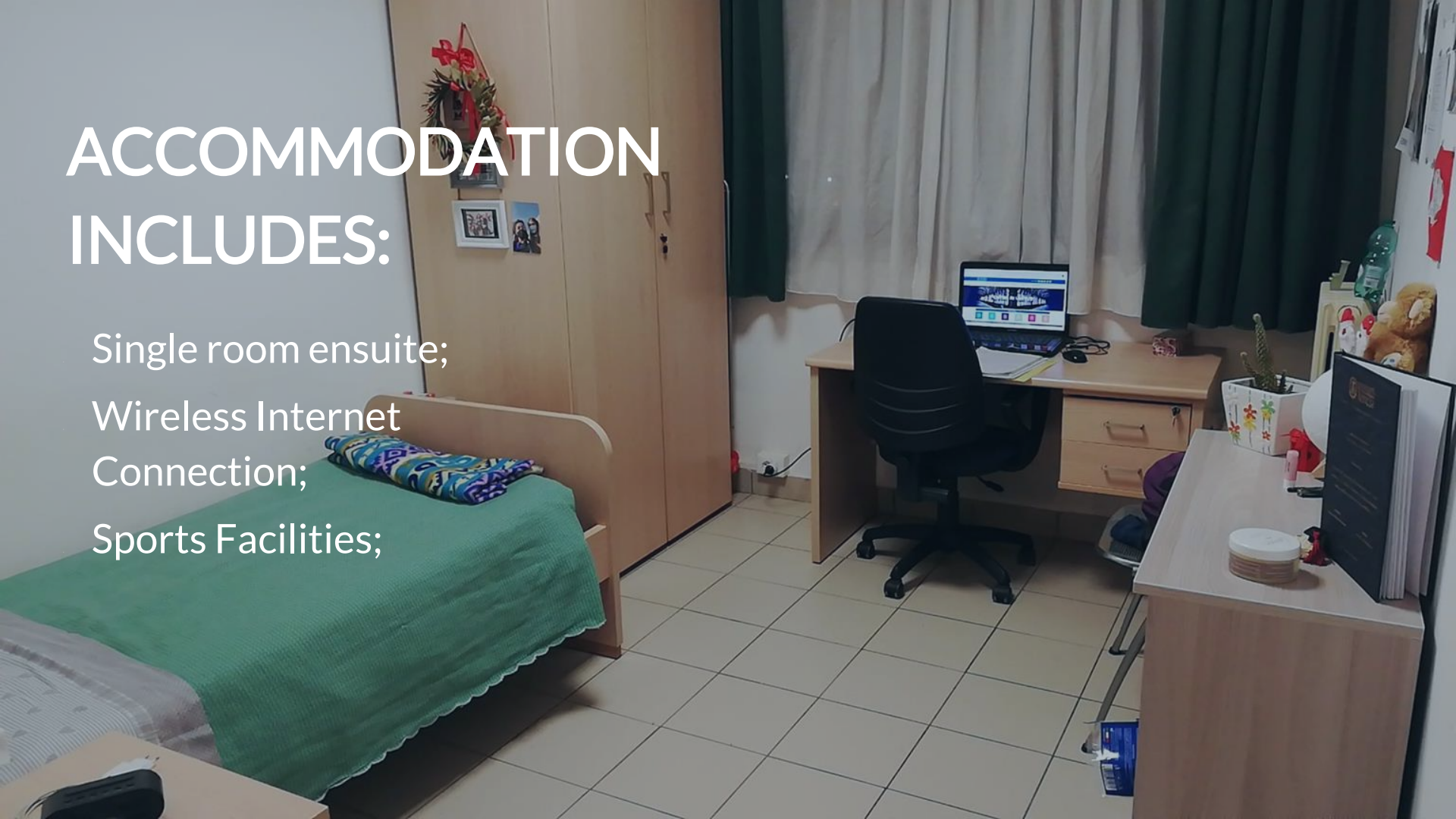
